Lima - Arequipa - Puno - Cuzco

12 Days / 11 Nights

DAY.01: INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT – LIMA

Arrive Lima Meeting Services and Transfer from the airport to the Hotel.
Night at the Hotel.

DAY.02: LIMA

Breakfast

This Excursion offers the best combination of the different attractions in Lima and its three historical periods: pre-Hispanic, colonial and contemporary.

In Lima, there were several different pre-Columbian cultures which are dated thousands of years back. Lima was part of the Inca Empire until was founded by the Spaniard Francisco Pizarro on the 18th of January, 1535. During our guided tour we will travel along, it's millenary history.

ANCESTRAL LIMA. At the Huaca Pucllana, and archaeological precinct build in the IV century A.C. we will have a panoramic view of this magnificent ceremonial and administrative centre which was considered by the Incas a holy village. We will learn about the life and rituals of its ancient inhabitants and admire its typical pyramidal building, very characteristic of sacred pre-Hispanic edifications which were adored in the coast of Peru.

COLONIAL LIMA. The Peruvian Viceroyalty was the most important one in the Spanish Empire and Lima was its capital. The highlights of its historical centre are its architecture and the urban design of the City, found in told street filled with colonial houses adorned with Moorish-style balconies. Our trip includes the paseo de la Republica (promenade of the Republic), Plaza San martin (San martin Square) and the Plaza Mayor (main Square) with their different buildings: Palacio de Gobierno (Government Palace), Palacio Arzobispal, the (Archbishop's palace), the Basilica Cathedral (Cathedral Basilica) and the Palacio Municipal (Municipal Palace). We will enter the monumental Convento de San Francisco (Convent of Saint Francis), which displays the biggest collection of religious art in American. We can admire the Choir room and the Monk's Library, the Sacristy, with its collection of Zurbaran and Rivera paintings. The Big patio of the Main Cloister, decorated with sevillan tyles from the XVI century, its beautiful Moorish, arches and its subterranean crypts known as the Catacombs.

CONTEMPORARY LIMA. Visit to the most traditional residential areas in the capital: The Olive Grove of San isidro, Miraflores and Iarco Mar, distinctive tourist centre of contemporary Lima.

Lunch Includes.

PERUVIAN GOLD MUSEUM A spectacular collection of Peruvian Ancient Gold and the Arms of the World Collection. Ancient Peruvians were master metalworkers. The "cire perdue" or lost wax process, known across the Orient and lost in the West until the Renaissance was the most frequent technique uses by master ancient Peruvian gold and silversmiths.

On our tour of Peru's gold Museum, visitors will appreciate a dazzling collection of gold artefacts from various pre-colombian civilizations, some more than 3,000 years old. Metal pieces and Jewellery of incalculable value in gold, silver and precious stones used by the Incas, the Children of the Sun God and monarchs of the vast Inca Empire are shown in this collection.

Peru`s Gold Museums also houses a valuable collection of old and modern weapons that ranks among the best in the world. The halls in this section show the Arms of the World Collection of armour , uniforms and various ancient war artifacts and weapons from various time periods around the world , some dating back to as long ago as 1300 B.C.

DAY.03 : LIMA – AREQUIPA

Breakfast

On time transfer from the Hotel to the airport to take the flight to Arequipa, meeting services and transfer to the hotel.

Carmen Alto: we can see the Chili River, surround by the natural and singular view of Arequipa, in this place you can enjoy the natural and delicious juice of Papaya Arequipeña and tumbo (a typical sour fruit)

Yanahuara Balcony: Located 2 kilometers from the downtown, it is placed at the same district of Yanahuara, in this place we can found the old beautiful and narrows streets as well.

Plaza de Armas: This is the main square of Arequipa in here were done the most famous event since Arequipa`s foundation in August 15th 1540. In the main front it is located the beautiful Cathedral.

Santa Catalina Monastery: In the most important and impressionist religious monument of Peru. It was founded in September 1579 by Santa Catalina de Siena; it was close for the people until 1970. It has 20,426 m2, still has the same characteristic from the XVI and XVII centuries its narrows streets, gardens, squares with Spanish names remember us the old towns of Sevilla and Granada.

DAY.04: AREQUIPA – COLCA

Breakfast

At 8:00 am approximately the bus start picking up the passengers, with destiny towards Colca Canyon; during the trip you can see the beautiful landscape, Andes, mountains, and the vicuñas reserve. We arrive in Chivay at 13:00 hours approximately then we will go to the Caleras the Thermo-medicinal waters 15 minutes from Chivay, over here you will need a bathing suit, after some time we come back to the hotel room in Chivay. In the afternoon we can go around the town and visit the craft shops.

DAY.05 : COLCA – PUNO

Breakfast

At. 06:00 am we have continental breakfast, then we go to the Colca canyon and observe the condor`s flight, coming back by the same place we can observe the pre-Incas hanging graves, the terraces view point and little towns like Pinchollo, Maca, Yanque, etc. we will stop one by one 20 minutes approximately we will arrive in Chivay about 13:00 hours. , then go by bus to Puno.

DAY.06: PUNO – UROS & TAQUILE

Breakfast

Tour 10 hours of traditional boat starts at 07:00 and ends around 17:00 hrs, includes visit to the Uros Floating Islands and Taquile.

Taquile is an island you'll take to a community that preserves its unique ancient customs and crafts of weaving and loom point.

Lunch in Taquile.

Return to Puno.

Night at the Hotel.

MAY.07 : PUNO CUZCO

Breakfast

Transfer from the hotel to the bus station for departure to Cuzco, leaving at 05:15 hrs. Arriving in Cuzco at 17:30 visiting on the way, Andahuaylillas, Raqchi, the Raya and Pukara, including entrance ticket to archaeological centers mentioned. Buffet lunch in a tourist restaurant in Sichuan, including board snack service, hot and cold drinks.

Arrival in Cuzco, reception and transfer to Hotel
Night at the Hotel in Cusco.

DAY.08: CUZCO - VALLE SAGRADO – MACHU PICCHU

We will pick you up half an hour before the train departure, from Ollantaytambo Station. We take the train to Machupicchu and after One and a half hour train ride aprox. We reach the station at Aguas Calientes,

DAY.09: MACHU PICCHU – CUZCO

Breakfast Buffet

Where we board a bus to climb the "ancient summit" up to Machupicchu. Your guide will gather a group and have a two-hour walk through the most important sites of this ancient citadel.

We'll visit the archaeological park of Saqsaywaman (The fortress-temple), and the nearby shrines of K'enqo (funeral worship) and Tambomach'ay (cleansing water rituals), beside the ancient Tambo of Pukapukara

At 19:00 transfer to the Dama Juana Restaurant to have a Buffet lunch with Folkloric dance. Return to the Hotel
